Bell lifts McQuaid to team track titles

Junior Tomarris Bell won the long jump and high jump to lead McQuaid to the Section V Class B team title Saturday at Hobart College.

Bell won the high jump with a leap of 6 feet, 7 inches, and the long jump in 22-1¾ for the Knights, who edged second-place Newark by four points.

Senior Daniel Serianni of Aquinas won the 1,600 and 3,200 to lead the Little Irish to a fifth-place finish.

Junior Jamiee McClary finished first in the 55 and the 55 hurdles to lead Mercy to the girls Class B title. The Monarchs had 144 points, 67 more than second-place Aquinas.

Jessica Walker won the long jump and triple jump to lead the Little Irish.
