**Wegman '65, Warmenhoven '68, lead companies
that are on *Fortune* magazine's 100 Best Cos. to work for**

ROCHESTER, N.Y., JAN. 22, 2008...The two Dans did it again. Wegmans Food Markets CEO Danny Wegman, (McQuaid Jesuit Class of '65), and Network Appliance CEO Dan Warmenhoven (McQuaid Jesuit Class of '68), once again led companies that *Fortune* magazine recognized as two of the best companies to work for in the United States. Wegman's company, Wegmans Food Markets, ranked No. 3 on Fortune's 2008 "[Best Companies to Work For](#)" list, the 10th-straight year the supermarket chain has appeared. Warmenhoven's company, Network Appliance, was No. 14 on the list, the sixth-straight year the data management company made the list. The special annual issue of *Fortune* will be published Feb. 4.

McQuaid Jesuit is a private, Catholic college preparatory school for young men in grades 7-12. It is named for the first Catholic Bishop of Rochester, the Most Rev. Bernard J. McQuaid. The school's mission is to foster the development of the spiritual, intellectual, physical, emotional and aesthetic talents of young men through personal concern for each student, competitive educational programs, a distinctive Jesuit spirit, and a formative sense of community. McQuaid Jesuit offers nearly \$1 million in financial aid to students in grades 7-12 who qualify academically, but don't have the financial resources to attend.
