McQuaid is offering an **Algebra 2/Trigonometry Preview Class** this summer. The purpose is to give students who have previously struggled in math a head start on the course curriculum, while creating a solid foundation of essential Algebra and Trigonometry concepts and skills.

Based on teacher recommendations and/or past performance in mathematics, your son has been identified as a student who would benefit from this opportunity. This class will review topics to prepare students for the beginning of their Algebra 2/Trig course in the Fall. Topics include solving equations (linear, quadratic, and rational), factoring polynomials, linear inequalities, and functions. A maximum of 12 students will be accepted.

LOCATION: McQuaid Jesuit campus; report to the main entrance (door #1)

INSTRUCTOR: Mrs. Kristi Mabelis, McQuaid Jesuit math teacher and department chair

MATERIALS: Students should arrive with their school-issued iPad, a notebook, and pen or pencil
